

## Amen Contributes to the Steve Pinkston Endowment

Many of your sons may know Mr. Steve Pinkston at Bellarmine; he has worked there for the past 40 years! Mr. Pinkston has served as teacher, coach, administrator, mentor, and spiritual leader; making deep connections with so many young people. He is retiring this June and Bellarmine is honoring him by creating the Steve Pinkston Endowment.

At the February AMEN board meeting, the board members discussed the Steve Pinkston Endowment Fund, as well as all our financial donations (BCP Financial Aid Program, and Presentation and Notre Dame High Schools). Kim Loquaci presented to the board the concept of the new endowment. The endowment is a specific fund within the larger Bellarmine Endowment that will support the salary of the Pinkston Fellowship, which will be open to recent college graduates and graduate students, of racially and culturally diverse descent who wish to serve at Bellarmine either through teaching, coaching, counseling or faith-based ministry. The board voted unanimously to pass a new annual donation to the Steve Pinkston Endowment with the first contribution to the fund this spring of a \$1,000.00!

At the end of the event, the participants pack up everything they brought in and the space is emptied as though nothing had occurred.
