Look at how adorable (and simple) the sugar cookies are below! They are perfect for your special Valentine! These cookies freeze beautifully too so they are a perfect make ahead treat! Ann Clark has wonderful cookie cutters!

Sugar Cookies

Ingredients:

c. of unsalted butter, softened
1/2 c. confectioner's sugar
egg
1/2 tsp. vanilla extract
3/4 c. all-purpose flour
tsp. baking powder
tsp. salt

Instructions:

Cream together softened butter and confectioner's sugar. Add the egg and vanilla extract to the butter sugar mixture and mix until thoroughly incorporated. In a separate bowl, sift together the flour, baking powder, and salt, then gradually add to the mixture. The dough is ready when it no longer sticks to the sides of the bowl.

Roll out on parchment to 1/4 inch thick and use flour for dusting as necessary. Cut and bake at 400 degrees for 7-8 minutes.

Royal Icing

Ingredients:

- 2 pounds confectioner's sugar
- 5 tablespoons meringue powder
- 2-3 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1/2-3/4 cups warm water

Instructions:

Begin by stirring the vanilla extract into half the water.

Using a paddle attachment, gently mix the sugar and meringue powder.

With the mixer on its lowest setting slowly add the water/vanilla mix to the dry ingredients.

Continue to add the remaining water (this may or may not be the entire amount) until the mixture reaches a thick, honey like consistency. At this point, turn the mixer to medium speed and whip 2-4 minutes until this icing is thick and fluffy. Mixing time can vary greatly so watch carefully and stop mixing when the icing forms a soft peak.
