Bellarmine COVID Travel Protocol (As of August 15, 2022)

This policy applies to all school-sponsored overnight travel such as retreats, immersion trips, and co-curricular activities. When moderators are traveling with students, they must have the students' Consent to Treat forms with them at all times in the event of a medical emergency. In the event a student tests positive while on a trip, moderators should contact Mark Moreno (408-550-5054) as their first point of contact.

Pre-Travel Guidelines

Day of travel: students will be screened for symptoms. Students are also required to take a rapid antigen test 24 hours prior to air travel and show a picture of the test result with the time stamp taken the morning before departure to the lead faculty chaperone.

Close contacts: If a member of the student's immediate family who lives in the same household (or with whom the student has been visiting) tests positive within 5 days of scheduled student travel, the student must notify the lead faculty moderator for the trip as soon as possible.

Moderators will take a school-issued kit which contains extra Masks and Covid antigen tests, plus additional items, with them on the trip.
