Bellarmine Illness Protocol

In school –

- 1. If your son is not feeling well throughout the school day, he should check in with the dean's office.
- 2. The dean's office will send the student to the athletic training room for a rapid antigen covid test.
- 3. Upon a negative test, the student will be sent home.
 - a. Criteria for return to school:
 - i. Improvement of symptoms
 - ii. Fever free for 24 hrs. without the aid of medicines.
- 4. Upon a positive test, the student will be isolated, sent home, and enter the covid protocol (see below), and the family will be notified immediately.

A. Bellarmine COVID-19 Protocol

If you have tested positive for COVID-19, you must stay home for at least 5 days. A negative test on Day 5 or later, symptom improvement, and NO fever for 24hrs; you may return to school/work (with proof of negative test). It is recommended that you wear a mask for up to 10 days while around others. If you are unable to test negative during the 10-day infectious period, you may return on Day 11 without a negative test.

Out of school -

- 1. If your son misses school for an illness, you must call the attendance line (408-294-0645) to report.
- 2. You must have a negative covid test to return to school.
 - a. A negative can be obtained a couple of ways
 - i. By your primary health care provider
 - ii. A home rapid antigen test

- 3. Your son must have improvement of symptoms
- 4. Your son must be fever free for 24 hrs. without the aid of medicines
