Gardening Group - A Taste of Honey

In October, the AMEN Garden Group gathered for a tour and honey tasting in the Bellarmine Garden. New Bellarmine Garden Steward, Collin Del Carlo, '19, led the group on the garden tour where he described the steps in composting, reviewed the various seasonal vegetables planted, introduced the goats and chickens, and identified the many fruit varieties ready for fall harvest: grapes, pears, apples, persimmon, and figs. At the

center, the garden's honeybee boxes and the adjacent natural pollinator garden were teaming with butterflies and bees. The tasting included both the '22 and '23 early fall honey harvest, as well as two others from the Santa Cruz Mountains. The mountain honey was darker in color and had a dramatically different smell and taste from the Bellarmine Garden honey. These differences are attributed to the different plant species available for pollen collection. The garden tour concluded with sweet treats baked with honey by co-chairs, Teresa and Lisa, as well as freshly pressed apple cider. What a magical place for students and the larger Bellarmine community to learn about the wonder of nature.
